STUDENT CONDUCT

All students are expected to comply with the same rules of conduct as apply within the Westfield Schools at other times of the year. The Summer School reserves the right to exclude, without refund of tuition, those students who do not follow these rules and standards.

ATTENDANCE

The intensive program is a two-week session. In order to receive credit it is imperative students are in attendance. The student will be dropped from the course due to **any** absence. Two tardies are equivalent to one absence. **No tuition will be refunded if the student is dropped or fails due to tardiness.**

Please note: All courses follow the curriculum of the Westfield Public School District. **The English 11-12 course is a half credit. All other High School courses are worth one credit.** All students should check with the school they attended during the regular school year to make sure that these courses will be accepted.

REGISTRATION

In-person registration will take place at Westfield High School from 2pm-5pm on June 26th and from 11am-1pm on June 28th in the main office entrance.

Final registration for Session 2 will take place from 6 - 8 p.m. on July 17th at Westfield High School. Anyone registering after July 3rd for Session 1 only, OR Session I AND Session 2; or after July 17th for Session 2 only must pay a late fee of \$25.00.

Mail-in registration must be received by July 3rd. Follow payment procedures below and mail c/o Summer School Director, Westfield High School, 177 Montgomery Rd., Westfield, MA 01085.

PAYMENT

No cash or personal checks will be accepted. Payment must be either a bank check or a money order made payable to the City of Westfield for each course taken. The student's name and the course registered for must appear on the check for each course taken.

ENROLLMENT

It is advisable that you register as soon as possible. When the maximum enrollment is reached, the course will be closed. Courses may be added if there is sufficient demand and a qualified instructor is available.

CANCELLATIONS

If a course is canceled because of insufficient enrollment, you will be notified on or before the first day of class.
