Dear Parents/Guardians,

The purpose of this letter is to inform you of the procedures that are followed for a delayed opening, early release, or school closure due to inclement weather or other emergencies.

During periods of potential and actual storms, school personnel are in contact with the Department of Public Works, Police, and Fire Departments. In addition, local and national weather stations are monitored. Please be aware that regardless of the district's decision, parents must make the final decision concerning school attendance because they know the degree of hazard in their own neighborhood. If they feel conditions are unsafe, parents should not hesitate to keep their child home.

An automated calling system will be activated to announce a delay, an early release, or closing. Also, the following radio and television stations broadcast announcements: WHYN (FM-93.1/AM-560), WAQY (FM-102), WRNX (FM-100.9), KIX (FM-97.9), Channel 40 WGGB, Channel 22 WWLP, CBS 3, local Channel 15 or you may call the School Information Line 572-6417. This year, parents/guardians may also opt-in to have a text message delivered to their cellphone. TWO HOUR DELAYED OPENING

Whenever possible, a two hour delay will be used in lieu of closing for the full day. In rare instances, we may change a delay into a cancellation if conditions worsen in the early morning hours. Therefore, please monitor television and radio stations until your student's departure for the most up-to-date information. On days of a delayed opening, breakfast and morning snack in schools will be cancelled and school lunch will be available.
